Conditions of Participation

1. Registration

The registration is made by completing the registration form of the respective Hanseatic City. The participation is limited to 100 people. In the registration System on the website

each Hanseatic City can register up to 2 participants. If you would like to register more participants, please contact us by e-mail under info@hansetagebrilon.de. At the time of arrival, each participant signs in on a list. By signing up, he or she recognizes the conditions of participation in the YouthHansa program.

2. Costs

The participation fee is 90.00 EUR (including VAT) per person and will be invoiced to the registered Hanseatic City. **With this participation fee all costs for accommodation, meals, the program and the Hanseparty are covered**. Each Hanseatic City is responsible for traveling costs of the participants.

3. Accommodation

Participants of the YouthHansa program will be staying in a youth hostel (Hölsterloh 3, 59929 Brilon) in more bedded rooms.

4. Clothing

Since some of the workshops are taking place outdoors, participants should bring weatherproof clothes and shoes.

5. Minimum age

Each Participant must be at least 15 years old. Participants under the age of 16 must bring an underwritten permission from their parents.

6. Risk and insurances

At the beginning of the program, the participants receive a safety briefing from the organisation team. At events like this, despite the greatest possible safety precautions, not all risks can be excluded. There is no insurance for the participant provided by the organizer. An accident and health insurance is recommended. No liability shall be accepted for the loss of luggage, valuables or money.

7. Behaviour in the hostel

The drinking of alcoholic beverages in the hostel and on its property is generally prohibited. Intoxicated guests can be asked to leave the property as access to the house can be denied. Smoking in the hostel is not permitted.

8. Data protection

The personal data of the participants is processed and stored with electronic data processes. Data protection is guaranteed. We would like to inform you that photos and videos will be made and published during and after the event. Each participant gets the opportunity to contradict this upon registration.
