Artistic Statement

Young people are the future.

As a videographer, I started looking for what do these young people mean for the city? At which locations are the young people making their dreams come true?

This video shows young people who all have a dream. To reinforce this, the actual passions in their own living environment have been mapped in a dreamy way.

The city of Doesburg gives young people the freedom to do what they enjoy and to develop their talents. This can be in sports and games, creativity, social or political level.

It is nice to see that young people are still flexible in their lives to let go of the beaten track and to follow their heart. A street art artist from the city aims to travel the world to give the world more color. Doesburg gives this creative person a nice local stage.

Civil society organizations in Doesburg approach young people to increase their awareness of their own living environment by capitalizing on young people's talents. Through this use of street art, among other things, the young people also contribute to a greater responsibility for a better living environment in the city.

The city gives young people a place in local politics with a children's council and a children's mayor.

The mayor of children wants to be able to mean something to other children by being a voice for them. Together with the children's council, consideration is given to the needs of young people in the city.

All these passions and dreams take place in the historic city center, but also outside the characteristic center of the Hanseatic city of Doesburg.
